BASICS OF GST



GST is a comprehensive, multi-stage, destination -based tax levied on every value addition in the supply chain. It replaces indirect taxes, such as VAT, excise duty, and service tax.

TYPES OF GST

- CGST (Central GST): Collected by the Central Government.
- SGST (State GST): Collected by State Governments.
- IGST (Integrated GST): Applied to inter-state transactions and collected by the Central Government.
- UTGST (Union Territory GST): Applied in Union Territories without a legislature.

GST RATES

GST has multiple tax slabs: 0%, 5%, 12%, 18%, and 28%, depending on the nature of the goods or services. Essential items like food grains are exempt, while luxury items attract higher rates.

- 0%: Essential items like fresh vegetables.
- 5%: Basic goods like packaged food.
- 12% & 18%: Common goods and services.
- 28%: Luxury items and sin goods.

GST operates on an Input Tax Credit (ITC) system. This system allows businesses to claim credit for taxes paid on inputs, ensuring they only pay taxes on the value added.



GST REGISTRATION PROCESS

WHO NEEDS TO REGISTER FOR GST?

- Businesses with an annual turnover exceeding ₹40 lakh (₹20 lakh for special category states). For Service Providers, it is ₹20 lakh (₹10 lakh for special category states).
- E-commerce operators, inter-state suppliers, and others under specific criteria.



STEPS TO REGISTER FOR GST

- Visit the GST Portal: <u>www.gst.gov.in</u>.
- Click on "Register Now" under the Taxpayers section.
- Fill in basic details: PAN, email ID, and mobile number.
- Submit documents like Aadhaar, PAN, business registration certificate, and address proof.
- Verify with OTP and upload the required documents.
- Receive GSTIN upon approval.



DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR GST REGISTRATION

- PAN Card of the business owner.
- Proof of business registration/incorporation.
- Bank account statement or canceled cheque.
- Aadhaar card and address proof of the owner.



TIPS FOR SMOOTH REGISTRATION

- Ensure all documents are up-to-date.
- Double-check the accuracy of your PAN and business details.
- Use a stable internet connection during the process.



03 FILING GST RETURNS STEP-BY-STEP



WHAT ARE GST RETURNS?

GST returns are documents containing details of sales, purchases, taxes collected, and taxes paid. They ensure the correct calculation and payment of GST.

HOW TO FILE GST RETURNS

- 1. Login: Access your account on the GST portal.
- 2. Choose Return Type: Select the return you wish to file.
- 3. Upload Invoices: Enter invoice details manually or upload them via bulk tools.
- 4. Verify Details: Cross-check all data, including taxes paid and input credits claimed.
- 5. Pay Tax: Use ITC or make payments via net banking or other modes.
- 6. Submit Return: Click on "Submit" and e-sign the return.

TYPES OF GST RETURNS

- GSTR-1: For reporting outward supplies.
- GSTR-3B: Summary of monthly transactions.
- GSTR-4: For composition scheme taxpayers.
- GSTR-9: Annual return for businesses.

KEY DEADLINES TO REMEMBER



- GSTR-1: 11th of every month.
- GSTR-3B: 20th of every month.
- Annual Return: December 31 of the following year.

COMMON MISTAKES TO AVOID



1. INCORRECT GSTIN



What It Means: The GST Identification Number (GSTIN) is a 15-digit unique code assigned to every registered business. Filing returns or issuing invoices with an incorrect GSTIN can result in return rejections or loss of ITC for your customers.

Example: A business issues an invoice to a client with a GSTIN "22ABCDE1234F2Z5" instead of "22ABCDE1234F1Z5." When the client files their return, they cannot claim ITC because the GSTIN doesn't match their records.

- Always cross-check the GSTIN while generating invoices or filing returns.
- Use software like MyKhataExpert to validate GSTINs automatically before submission.



2. LATE FILING

What It Means: Missing GST filing deadlines results in penalties and late fees. Additionally, delays can disrupt cash flow as ITC claims for that period may not be processed promptly.

Example: A business that misses the GSTR-3B filing deadline for September incurs a penalty of ₹50 per day (₹25 CGST and ₹25 SGST). For a delay of 15 days, the business pays ₹750, an avoidable expense.

Solution:

3. IGNORING RECONCILIATIONS

What It Means: Sales and purchase data must align with GST returns to claim ITC accurately. Ignoring reconciliations can lead to mismatches, denial of ITC, and audits.

Example: A business reports ₹10 lakh in sales in GSTR-1 but shows ₹9.5 lakh in GSTR-3B due to missing invoices. This discrepancy triggers a notice from the GST department.

4. INPUT TAX CREDIT (ITC) ERRORS
